





#### **Installation Access Request Requirements**


IAW POE (Principles of Excellence) 13607 and DoDI 1322.25 schools must meet specific criteria in order to gain installation access. Please read the following and note if your institution meets all the requirements:

Educational institutions may be allowed access to installations to provide on-installation education programs, services, and education guidance to their students and/or to participate in sanctioned education fairs if they meet all of these criteria:

- Have a signed Voluntary Education Partnership MOU with DoD.
- Are in compliance with state requirements and laws.
- Are state-approved for the use of veterans' education benefits (Post 9/11 GI Bill).
- Are certified to participate in federal student aid programs through the Department of Education.
- Are accredited by a national or regional accrediting body recognized by the Department of Education and conduct programs that support degree programs from that institution.





### **CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS**



Federal Tuition Assistance pays up to 21 SHs towards academic undergraduate or graduate certificates. Schools need to ensure their Academic Certificate programs have been loaded into the Academic Institution portal.

Soldiers are limited to using Federal Tuition Assistance towards ONE undergraduate or graduate certificate during their career, not to exceed 21 SHs.



### **CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS**



In many cases, Soldiers will be better off to pursue a degree since FTA will pay up to 130 SHs towards an undergraduate degree and 39 SHs towards a graduate degree versus only 21 SHs towards an undergraduate or graduate certificate.

For example, in some vocational programs at our community colleges, Soldiers complete the certificate portion during their first year and finish the degree portion their second year i.e. welding. Soldier's Education Goal is for a DEGREE.



## Courses Offered by Academic Institutions (Als)



Beginning 1 October 2024, Soldiers will only be able to request Tuition **Assistance for courses that the Academic Institution (AI) has loaded** into the Al Portal. Soldiers will be unable to manually add courses if the courses are not in the system.

### **POSTING OF GRADES IN THE AI PORTAL**

Schools and vendors are required to submit grades through the Academic Institution (AI) Portal within 30 days from course end date.

If grades are not posted, the Soldier's ArmylgnitED account goes on HOLD and the Soldier may be subject to recoupment.



### **COURSE WITHDRAWALS**



A WITHDRAWAL is not the same as a DROPPED course.

Schools should only enter a grade of "W" if the student is going to be charged for the course.

If a grade of "W" is entered, the Soldier's ArmylgnitED account will be placed on HOLD and the Soldier will be subject to RECOUPMENT.

If a Soldier DROPPED the course during the add/drop period and will not be charged, please remove the course from the invoice.



# DROPPED/DELETED COURSES



**Soldiers** can delete the TAR in ArmylgnitED if the decision is made **PRIOR** to the start date.

After the start date, the Soldier should contact the Al immediately. The Al can invoice prior to 19% if the invoice is zero dollars.

When the Al invoices a course for zero dollars, the course is deleted by the system when the invoice is processed by Finance.



### **INVOICES**



Schools can invoice after a Soldier has completed 19 percent of their courses.

Questions regarding invoices must be directed to ArmylgnitED School Support.

Counselors do not have visibility of the Al portal or school invoices.



## REJECTED INVOICES



When a Soldier submits a TA Approval form, please verify the course dates are correct.

If a Soldier inputs and submits a TA Approval form with the WRONG course dates, schools cannot invoice for the course.

If the END DATE of the course is incorrect, an education counselor can correct the TA Request in certain cases.

If the BEGIN DATE of the course is incorrect, the TA Request cannot be corrected and FTA will not be paid for the course.




- What is it What do I get?
  - Financial assistance to help Soldiers with offduty voluntary civilian educational pursuits
  - 100% of tuition cost up to \$250 per semester hour (\$167 per quarter hour, or \$5.55 per clock hour)
  - Up to 16 semester hours (\$4,000.00) per fiscal year
    - For FY-25, that covers courses with start dates between 1 Oct 2024 and 30 Sep 2025







- Career limits for FTA are:
  - 130 undergraduate semester hours
  - 39 graduate semester hours
  - 21 semester hours towards an undergraduate <u>or</u> graduate <u>CERTIFICATE</u>.
  - FTA will not pay for a second (duplicate) or lower degree at any level, regardless of the funding used for the first degree
  - FTA does not cover fees or books







- May be used with GI Bill benefits
- May be used with the Mississippi National Guard General Scholarship Program (Mississippi Schools Only)
- TA Requests may be submitted up to 60 days prior but NLT 14 days prior to a Course Start Date to ensure TA Requests are processed and approved PRIOR to a Course Start Date. The system prevents the input of TARs 7 days prior to course start date.





How Does a Soldier Qualify?

Be currently serving in the ARNG and have a military CAC.

**NOT FLAGGED** 







- Career limits for FTA are:
  - 130 undergraduate semester hours
  - 39 graduate semester hours
  - 21 undergraduate OR graduate CERTIFICATE SHs
  - FTA will not pay for a second or lower degree at any level, regardless of the funding used for the first degree
  - FTA does not cover fees or books





- GPA Requirements to prevent account HOLD
  - 2.0 Undergraduate / 3.0 Graduate
  - If placed on HOLD, Soldier must self-fund through ArmylgnitED until GPA HOLD is lifted
- Recoupment
  - Soldiers agree to reimburse the Army when they receive an unsatisfactory grade
  - Receiving a grade of a "W" or "D" or below for an undergraduate course
  - Receiving a grade of a "W" or "C" or below for a graduate course







- Recoupment Waiver Requests (DA 7793)
  - Withdrawal for Military Reasons
     (unanticipated/unexpected reasons, such as
     emergency leave/reassignment, natural or man made disasters, illness/hospitalization, or unforeseen
     military mission)
  - Must be submitted <u>no later than 30 days</u> after a school posts a "W" grade (previously, it was 3 years)
  - Receipt of grades other than a "W" are not eligible for Recoupment Waiver



# Soldier Process Overview ArmylgnitED.army.mil



- Establish ArmylgnitED Account by going to <a href="https://www.armyignited.army.mil/student">https://www.armyignited.army.mil/student</a> and clicking "Get Started" (CAC ID required)
- 2. Request an Education Goal (select your school and degree program)
- 3. Submit Evaluated Degree Plan when requesting Education Goal

Note: If an Evaluated Degree Plan is not submitted when requesting an Education Goal, a HOLD will be placed on account after completing two courses.



## **Evaluated Degree Plan REQUIRED for Soldiers**



An Evaluated Degree Plan / Degree Progress Report / Degree Audit for Soldiers is required PRIOR to completion of two courses, or their account will go on HOLD. Soldiers need to upload their Evaluated Degree Plan when submitting their Education Goal. Soldiers should be able to log into their school's student portal to download/save their degree plan. If their degree plan is NOT available via student portal, they need to contact the school and request an Evaluated Degree Plan.

#### An Evaluated Degree Plan includes:

- √ school's name
- ✓ Soldier's name
- √ degree being pursued
- √ total number of hours required to complete the degree
- √ total number of hours already completed with school
- ✓ total number of transfer hours that were applied towards the degree program
- ✓ total number of hours remaining for graduation
- ✓ Remaining courses to take: Course Name, Subject, Course Number, and

Number of Hours i.e. College Algebra, MATH 1313, 3 hrs

- 4. Enroll in Courses at your School.
- 5. Return to ArmylgnitED and Request TA for the Courses you want to use TA for.

Note: TA Requests may be submitted up to 60 days prior but NLT 14 days prior to a Course Start Date to ensure TA Requests are processed and approved PRIOR to a Course Start Date.

The system prevents the input of TARs 7 days prior to course start date.



# Soldier Process Overview ArmylgnitED.army.mil



Put in your TA Requests **ONE** course at-a-time, click "submit" and "finished." Repeat until you have a TAR for each course. Use the **CORRECT** start and end dates for each class.

Can't see your courses and/or term start and end dates? Call your school to request they add the information into the AI portal which feeds ArmylgnitED.

6. Once courses are approved, go back into ArmylgnitED, print the authorization form and provide the form to the school.

# STATE EDUCATION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (SEAP)





### State Education Assistance



### MS National Guard General Scholarship Program

- Pays up to \$10,000 per State FY (1 Jul-30 Jun)
  - \$5,000 per semester for MS Colleges/Universities
  - \$2,500 per semester for MS Community Colleges
- Based on FT/PT status. SMs less than FT will get half the fulltime rate.
- SMs using Post 9/11 GI Bill may use SEAP but are capped at the part-time rate.
- May be combined with GI Bill benefits and Federal Tuition Assistance.
- Funds are paid as a general scholarship instead of tuition only
- APPLY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE!

### MS National Guard General Scholarship Program

- How does a Service Member Qualify?
  - Basic Training Graduate
  - Registered voter in the State of Mississippi
  - Actively serving in good standing (not flagged) and serving through the end of the semester
  - •Maintain a 2.0 GPA
  - Pursuing first undergraduate degree or vocational program
  - •SM must apply with new application for every semester that funds are requested
